Municipalities' Proposed Transportation Planning Studies

Tab	Municipality - Title	Requested Amount - Objective
A	Aventura – On Board Survey, Ridecheck & Development of New Schedule	\$24,742 – To collect data related to passenger boardings, customer satisfaction, and schedules for expanded transit circulator service. To develop a bus stop inventory and prepare ride check sheets for each trip in the system.
Hi	Hialeah – Service Enhancements to the Hialeah Transit System (HTS)	\$20,000 – To examine potential HTS express transit service by examining the existing service with the intention of providing services on less congested roads on the periphery of the city and linking key attractions and destinations.
Ho	Homestead - East/West Transit System Connector to Busway	\$150,000 – To provide accessibility and enhancement of businesses and residential growth in the city by performing a design and study of the proposed East West Transit system connector.
NM	North Miami – Bicycle Parking and Transit Circulator Feasibility Study	\$64,000 – To conduct a comprehensive bicycle planning and transit circulator feasibility study in order to provide better bicycle facilities and identify strategies that will create greater connectivity between bicycle and public transit systems.
NMB	North Miami Beach – Pedestrian/Bicycle Safety	\$20,000 – To study pedestrian/bicycle safety at the intersection of North Miami Beach Blvd (NE 163 rd St/SR826) and Biscayne Blvd (US1/SR5).
P	Pinecrest – Feasibility Study on providing MDT Park-and-Ride facility	\$34,500 – To conduct a feasibility study on providing an MDT park-and-ride facility along with associated transit feeder services to provide direct services and to determine feasible ways to enhance mobility options for residents and visitors and provide better alternatives to the use of single occupant vehicles in South Dade along US-1 corridor.
P	Pinecrest – US 1 Intersection Study	\$30,000 – To help define intersection improvements that would accommodate existing and future growth while protecting and enhancing mobility, economic prosperity and quality of life along US 1 between SW 88 th Street and SW 136 th Street.
SI	Sunny Isles - Master Thoroughfare Plan	\$143,279 – To perform data collection, public involvement and transportation planning tasks associated with the development of a citywide Master Thoroughfare Plan.
SW	Sweetwater – Elevated People Mover System	\$34,000 – To examine methodically feasible transportation options concentrating on the costs and benefits associated with the construction of an automated, elevated people mover system.

Total requested \$520,051 excluding 20% required minimum local match.
